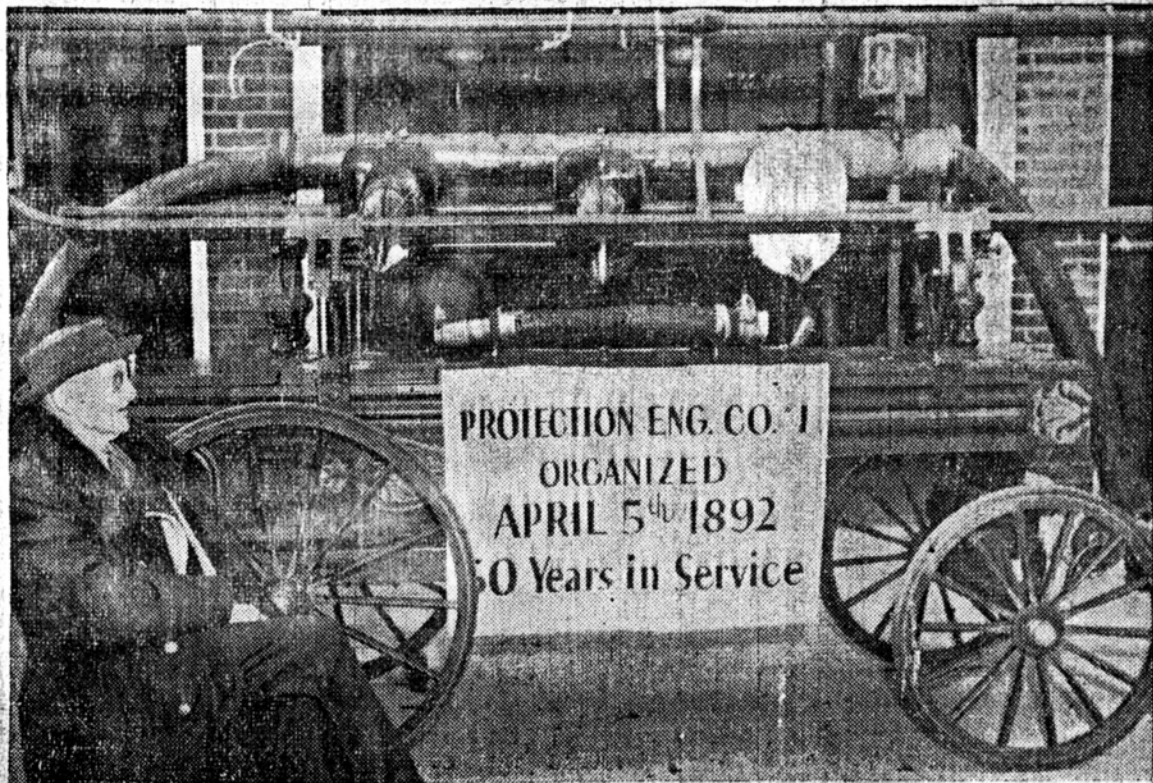


## Fought Port Washington Fires 50 Years Ago
