At a Five Board mosting several months ago the Flower IIII Hose Co. donated to the Five Department a Cadillac car to be used as an ambulance or reliaf car. The offer was accepted by the Department and suggestion was made of forming a Reliaf Corps of non; trained in first aid. At the December menting of the Fire Board, Rev. D. S. McAlpine was appointed a committee of one to confer with the Port Washington Ladies Hospital Auxiliary on the matter of converting and equipping this car as an ambulance.

The undersigned, officers of the Auxiliary, will turn over to Mr. Mc-Alpine \$800 of the \$800 which they collected for a hospital, toward this work; the remaining \$500 still drawing interest in the bank until such time as it is needed for a besiltal.

The ambulance will be kept at Five Headquarters and will be at the errivies of the antire community, and the Ausiliary fest that, as this money had been collected to equip a hospital, no better use could be made of this \$800 than to assist in equipping the ambulance until plans for the hospital are consumated.

It will carry the pulmotor now at Police Headquarters, obtained through the efforts of our late beloved Editor, William M. Hyde; will be fully equipped, and on rail at any time. It is hoped it may be in readiness early in April and will be ready for use as part of the Fire Department's equipment at the coming Nassau . County Volunteer Firemen's Tournament to be held here in June.
