ONE DIED HERE....The shell of the three-story frame building that took one life is all that remains of the 20-room Plandome Country Club following a fire of undetermined origin on Tuesday afternoon and evening of last week, December 23rd. Michael Psalmister, 65, of 2356, 61st Street, Brooklyn, was identified by his stepson, Raymond Berzowski of the same address. Psalmister, club houseman and caretaker, is survived by his wife, Catherine. Damage of the fire which apparently started in the boiler room, was estimated at \$350,000. Nassau County Fire Marshal Peter Lynch, who was at the scene, is probing the blaze. Club officials have announced plans to rebuild. They hope to have the clubhouse open by July 4th. The clubhouse, constructed more than 30 years ago, stands on a 108-acre, \$2,000,000 spread that includes an enclosed swimming pool and a golf course. It is located at 145 Stonytown Road, Plandome.
