BATTLING BLAZE that destroyed Bradley's Restaurant, famous local landmark, early Monday morning, February 19th, Port's volunteer vamps responded to the general alarm at 3:23 a.m., staying until 11:20 a.m., when a crew remained to pump out the cellar of the three-story, wooden structure at 346 Main Street, opposite the Town Dock, George R. Van Schaick Jr., of the Nassau County Fire Marshal's office said the fire was probably started by a careless cigarette. Damage, including the building and its contents, was sted at approximately \$100,000. (See story at right.)



Bradley's Restaurant, formerly known as "the landmark of hotels in Port Washington," was completely destroyed by fire early Monday morning, February 19th. (See photo at left, and others, elsewhere in this issue.)

Although the cause was undetermined, George R. Van Schaick Jr., of the County Fire Marshal's office said the fire possibly was started by a careless cigarette. He said that upon close investigation it was found that all wiring was perfect and that the oil burner and everything else was in perfect order.

Ironically, more than 500 guests had attended a new ownership cocktail party a few hours before on Sunday, February 18th, when Frank X, Statler, manager, served over 1,000 cocktails and many platters of canapes "on the house" from 5 p.m., to 7 p.m. Many of the guests stayed through the night and were probably partying as the smouldered.
