

Firemen Mourn Daniel Henderson Who Died At Fire

Funeral services were held on Sunday from his late residence, Davis Road, for the late Daniel Kennedy, Port Washington fireman who died last Thursday while on duty directing traffic at a fire call at 36 Mackey Avenue.

Whether it was the extreme heat or the excitement of the moment, is not known, but death was due to a heart attack. Mr. Henderson had been warned previously to abstain from excitement.

Mr. Henderson, who was a well-known contractor and carpenter here, is survived by his widow and a daughter.

A member of the Atlantic Hook and Ladder Co., and the Exempt Firemen, the local department honored his memory with services Saturday night.

Both the Rev. D. S. McAlpins and Rev. Merle Isenburg officiated at the services and at the interment in Nassau Knolls. Members of the Fire Department acted as pallbearers and escorted the body to its final resting place.

The funeral was under the direction of A. F. Knowles.
